

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We have been given strict advice from the WCBC Head of Education which follows Welsh Government guidance regarding the need to minimise the number of children and staff attending school during the current Coronavirus pandemic.

The guidance is clear. Please DO NOT send your child into school if you have someone else to take care of your child. Please see below:-

*“Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be and **only** where there is **no safe alternative should provision be made in schools or other settings**. If you are classed as a **critical worker but are able to perform the critical parts of your job effectively when working from home, then you should do so**. If one parent is a critical worker but the other parent is not then the other parent should provide safe alternative arrangements at home when possible.”*

Mr Ian Roberts, Head of Education also states: **"This is essential to ensure reducing further the number of children travelling to school and to ensure further social distancing."**

If your child is already booked into childcare in school, please think very carefully about your own circumstances. We must work together to limit the spread of the Coronavirus. We must ensure that as many of us can 'Stay Safe' and 'Stay at home.'
