


# St Mary's Children Take Over the Newsletter!

They will get a badge for completing this challenge. Da iawn!




The Price family, Izzy (y6), Noah (Y1) and big sister Stasia have recently moved house and have been busy helping with some 'wallpaper stripping.'

Ana (Y4) has been working hard on her school work.




Sophie (Y5) took part in the RAF Hurricane 80K Challenge, running, walking, cycling and hopefully swimming, at some point. She has already
